By reflecting on what has been learned, students will be able to comprehend and explain their studies from a global perspective.		
到達目標	<p>【一般目標 (GIO)】</p> <p>Students will learn basic concepts and essential terminology that will provide a stepping stone to further study in linguistics. Through reading textbooks and doing independent study, students will develop an understanding of key topics and issues in linguistics.</p> <p>【行動目標 (SBOs)】</p> <p>Students should understand the range of topics in the field of linguistics. Students should be able to retrieve information from the Internet on topics in linguistics that are relevant to their interests and situations. Students should be able to pick up topics of interest from the textbooks and comment on them in written and / or spoken form.</p>		
学修方略 (方法)	<p>【アクティブラーニングの有無・学修媒体等】</p> <p>Focus on selected topics from the textbooks. Write short summaries of those topics selected. Do further reading and research on the topics.</p> <p>【学修方略 (LS) と学修時間】</p> <p>Students will receive feedback and advice on format and content of their reports. Based on feedback from the teacher, students will revise and resubmit a final version of their report. Through repeated feedback and rewriting, students will improve the content of their report step by step and, in the process, develop their writing and critical thinking skills.</p> <p>Reading the textbook and supplementary texts - 25 hours  Writing a draft of a report, first submission, - 10 hours  Revising the draft, submit final version - 10 hours</p>		
スケジュール	<p>Semester 1: Two reports. One to be submitted by the end of May and the other by the end of June. The final version of each report must be submitted by the specified dateline in the academic calendar.</p> <p>Semester 2: Two reports. One to be submitted by the end of October and the other by the end of November. The final version of each report must be submitted by the specified dateline in the academic calendar.</p>

	レポート	60%	Students will be awarded points for the following aspects of their written work: organization, format, references, logic, discussion, <u>originality and creativity</u> .
	観察記録	40%	Students will access Manaba to take short quizzes and surveys. They will also be required to write short comments on parts of the textbook that they are particularly interested in. Points will be awarded for keeping to the deadline and regularly submitting work.
履修者への要望	Although students will be reading the same textbooks, they will have the freedom to focus on topics that particularly interest them and write about those topics as a major part of their assessment.
